## Description

Slidingdors (Dor= 'generation' in Hebrew) is a program started in December 2020 where American, Hungarian and Israeli second-generation holocaust survivors meet and discuss their unique Jewish identity. Through an integrated curriculum of in-person and online sessions, groups have local programming in their own communities as well as international online events together with other participants from the P2G family. As an additional program, a trip for participants of SlidingDors is scheduled in 2023 to Israel and/or Hungary

## Goals

1

Help the second generation from Israel, Budapest and the USA to understand their own unique Jewish identity by sharing their memories with each other both locally and with their peers from other communities

2

Initiate dialogue between the second and third generation as well as international connections for the "empty nest" generation

3

Ensure the continuation of the Jewish value of storytelling

## Measurable Objectives / Outcomes

1. At least six international online sessions throughout the year where participants from different P2G communities meet
2. Participants from 15 P2G communities
3. At least six local, in-person sessions throughout the year where local participants from the same P2G communities meet
4. At least 5 participants per community
5. At least two complementary projects in which participants may take part such as academic research, art exhibition, guest speakers who visit US communities on their Yom Ha'shoah event, special training for engaged participants who would like to share their stories publicly
