## Description

Connecting the Akko and Matte Asher music conservatories with musical institutes in our partnered communities in the US and Budapest and eventually form a global multicultural Chamber Orchestra.

In order to achieve these two goals, we would like to suggest the following programs for 2022:

**Nigun2Gether** – Following the success of the program with 11 musicians and music teachers from our partnered cities in the US and over 50 Israeli students and music teachers from the Akko and Matte Asher conservatories, we would like to continue with the virtual music lessons we began last year.

**Music2gether Orchestra Composition:** collaborating with a composer who will write a musical piece for the Partnership, which music students from all our partnered communities will study and perform at the celebration of the Partnership's 25th anniversary on 2023.

**Artists Community Virtual Network** – the Sub Committee would like to create a virtual platform for artists to connect, learn from one another and be engaged.

## Goals

To enhance the music education of students at the Akko and Matte Asher music conservatories

To create new P2G engagements through music that will develop and grow within all our communities

To impact our communities through music education, talented faculty and music performances

To expose the students and the musicians to multicultural music while engaging participants of all faiths

## Measurable Objectives / Outcomes

1. Have at least 20 music students connected to Music teachers from partnered cities, through Zoom.
2. Have at least 6 individual zoom meetings a year for the teachers and students.
3. Hold at least 1 concert a year for the music students and teachers.
4. Recruit musical institutes in at least two more communities to take part in the program
