## Description

Shalom Hartman Institute, Community Centers of Akko and Matte Asher and Partnership2Gether have joined together to develop a 2-year program curriculum for top community Jewish and non-Jewish leaders in the US and in the Western Galilee, focusing on learning sources from the different religions to create an interfaith dialogue among the participants.

The program would have two groups, one in Israel and one in the US.

In Israel we will collaborate with the Akko and Matte Asher Community Centers and in the US we would collaborate with the JCRC departments in the different federations to create a group.

During 2021 and 2022 -The two groups will have their own curriculum and also meet three-four times a year for a virtual mutual discussion

In October 2022 - The two groups will meet in Israel and/or in the USA

Break down barriers and stereotypes

Build a bridge between different religions and skin colors among Americans and Israelis

Connect between people and communities by learning about shared values, experiences and challenges from a variety of texts from all religions

## Measurable Objectives / Outcomes

1. Have a group of 20 Interfaith Israeli participants who participate in 75% of the meetings
2. Have a group of 20 Interfaith US participants who participate in 75% of the meetings
3. Have at least five communities participate

## TARGET AUDIENCE

<b>PRIMARY</b>	20 participants from the US and 20 participants from the Western Galilee
<b>SECONDARY</b>	Participants' families and the communities they are leading

## BUDGET

<b>Total Cost Of Program</b>	Partnership fee – \$30,000 per year Delegation – \$52,500 (Will be raised by O/A sources)
<b>Expected Participation Fee</b>	\$750 per participant X 20
<b>Funding From Other Sources</b>	Akko and Matte Asher community centers will pay \$10,000 each
<b>Total Request From Partnership</b>	\$10,000
