Description

A series of online, one-hour lectures on a variety of subjects, given by lecturers from the Western Galilee College, universities in the US and Budapest. Subjects may include diversity, the Middle East, the Holocaust, and various themes of culture and Judaism. In addition, with prior coordination, lectures on specific required subjects can be arranged. The lectures will be open to the wider communities (in and outside of Israel). Our hope is to create a speakers' bureau of experts in different fields.

Goals

1

Provide a series of lectures for adults in all our P2G communities

Develop an academic platform for connecting, learning and discussions in our Partnership to widen the circle of participants

3

Develop a relationship with lecturers for future connections (Speakers Bureau)

Measurable Objectives / Outcomes

1. Provide four to six sessions every year
2. At least thirty participants in each session
3. Ten participants will become friends of the Partnership/Federations i.e. participate in additional Partnership/Federation activities
