On-going Program One-time Program | Virtual Face to Face

Description

The program consists of a series of online sessions between students from the Western Galilee College and peers from the partnered communities. The goal is to learn about each other, discuss and explore contents related to various aspects of multiculturalism. The program will be led by lecturers in various fields from the WGC and associated institutes. By the end of the program, pairs of students from different colleges will present their joint final projects.

Number of online sessions: six to eight, with additional private meetings between students
Total number of students: 12-16.

Goals

1

Create personal, cross cultural discussions and connections between students and widen the circles of the younger generation in the Partnership

2

Create academic space and structure for co-learning and critical thinking around a specific topic

3

Inspire participants to share their experiences with their own local community as well as academics in the Partnership

Measurable Objectives / Outcomes

1. 40% of the students will stay in contact with their new friends
2. 75% of the students will participate in 85% of the sessions
3. Their final product will be presented to the Partnership and academic committee chairs
