On-going Program One-time Program | Virtual Face to Face

Description

The program offers the Sliding Dors participants an opportunity to experience the Western Galilee and Budapest in a unique way, including profound thought-provoking lectures, visit the Ghetto Fighters kibbutz and field trips. Participants will get a glimpse into the everyday life in our region, exposure to Partnership programs and activities, meet and do workshops with 2nd Gen's, and talk with the local residences at eye level.

Connect 2nd Gen's from the US with their peers in the WG and Budapest. Continue the Sliding Dors conversations and connections

Encourage further volunteer involvement in the Partnership/ federations

Measurable Objectives / Outcomes

1. Broaden participants' knowledge about the Partnership, at least five participants will participate afterward in the following programs: Learn2Gether, Café Olam, Book Club, and Parents2Gether (Budapest)
2. At least five participants will become involved in a Partnership/federation activity
3. Increase engagement of Israelis and Hungarians in our Partnership. (Additional 15 volunteers to our Israeli Database)
4. Widen the circles of Partnership engagement in the US communities (five more lay leaders)
